

PRE-SCHOOL PAYMENT POLICY

The Governor Wentworth Regional School District operates an integrated pre-school program in both the Ossipee Central School and the New Durham School. The programs have been established to provide special education opportunities for children with educational disabilities. In order to provide appropriate age and developmental models for these young children, the programs in each school are made available to a small number of non-disabled pre-school aged children on a space available basis. Lists of possible candidates will be maintained in each building and parents/guardians notified when openings occur.

Although the district provides for disabled children, non-disabled children will be charged a monthly tuition. This amount will be no greater than the going rate in similar settings. The rate will be determined annually by the District.

Tuition payment is due on the first of each month. Payment plans can be arranged through the Pre-School Coordinator if monthly payments are a financial hardship for parents/guardians. If the tuition payment is two months in arrears, the child will be dismissed from the program and the opening will be offered to the parents/guardians of the next child on the waiting list.
